### Rules and conditions

1. The contest is **\$2 win, \$2 place and \$2 show** on ten races from any track with a published post time between 12:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. on the contest day. **Participants may select only one horse per race.**
2. **All wagers must be placed at one of the official contest wagering terminals, by the entrant, prior to each race closing.** Advance wagering by the participant is permitted as soon as wagering is available on each contest race card as the tracks are available.
3. Wagers may be cancelled once placed for contest purposes (prior to wagering closing on that race). If your selection is scratched, you will receive a refund and be able to wager on a different race. In the event that the scratch takes place in the last available contest race, you will be refunded your \$6 wager which will then be added to your accumulated total.
4. **There is a 20 to 1 cap on the win wager (\$42 maximum payoff) , 10 to 1 cap on the place wager (\$22 maximum payoff) and 5 to 1 cap on the show wager (\$12 maximum payoff). The caps are for contest purposes only.**
5. All wagers must be placed by the entrant or contest coordinator. Failure to do so will result in contest disqualification for both the contestant and the person who placed the wager on the contestants behalf.
6. It is the responsibility of the contestant to ensure all wagers are placed correctly on their account.
7. The entrant who accumulates the biggest bankroll wins the contest. In the event of a tie, the prize money will be divided equally among the winners.
8. Contestants must be 18 years of age or older.
9. Each player agrees to abide by all published tournament rules and regulations. In the event of a dispute, tournament officials have the final say. All players agree that the decision of the contest officials is final. The contest officials have the right to disqualify any tournament entrant who has violated any of the rules and regulations. Assiniboia Downs reserves the right to add or delete any portion of the tournament rules and regulations. No discussion or correspondence will be entered into concerning the contest.
