

Mage's Kentucky Derby Win One For The Little Guy
Could the feisty son of a Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner take the Triple Crown?

When Mage won the 149th Kentucky Derby last Saturday at 14-1 it was a win for the little guy, and a few friends of friends of friends.

It seemed that everyone who knew someone who had handicapped the race had at least a couple of bucks on the feisty son of Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1) winner Good Magic. Heck, my mom even had two across on him, and why not?

Kirt picked Mage on the <u>ASD Live</u> Kentucky Derby Preview Show, which was a great tune up for their summer ASD handicapping show, and both Kirt and Stretch had numerous winners and cashable tickets in their picks on Derby Day. They missed the Pick-6, but it only paid \$978,372 for 20 cents. Maybe next time.

Mage was tagged by numerous trip handicappers after his second-place finish in the Florida Derby to scratched Kentucky Derby favourite Forte, but somehow managed to go off as an overlay. He came charging home to defeat Two Phil's (9-1), who had the highest Beyer Speed Figure in the field at 101. Post time favourite Angel of Empire (7/2) rallied for third, with Disarm (26-1) battling it out to take fourth money. Of the top four finishers, only Disarm would have been tough to have in your superfecta, but some bettors liked him.

The bargain play turned out to be the Mage-Two Phil's exacta, which returned \$319.80 for \$2. The 60-cent trifecta also paid decent at \$536.52, but the \$1 superfecta returned a whopping \$14,239.70 for those who were lucky enough to have Disarm on their ticket.

The connections of Mage weren't sure if they were going to run back in the Preakness Stakes on Saturday, May 20, but their horse was looking lively on the track just a few days after his monstrous win. Many were thinking it would be a real battle between Forte and Mage in the Preakness, but because Forte scratched out of the Derby due to a foot bruise, safety rules say he can't run back that quick.

Forte might not have been able to beat Mage in the Preakness regardless, as Mage looks like he is only now starting to peak. Could he win the Triple Crown?

He just might!

The new Western Canadian Triple Crown in thoroughbred racing not only has a nice ring to it, there is also an awareness of companionship attached that transmits goodwill within the sport.

That is precisely the feeling shared among Assiniboia Downs, Century Mile, and Hastings Racecourse as the three western racetracks band together to present a combined Derby extravaganza during the 2023 live racing season.

The Western Canadian Triple Crown connects the \$125,000 Manitoba Derby (August 7), the \$200,000 G3 Canadian Derby in Alberta (August 26) and \$125,000 G3 British Columbia Derby (September 16).

In addition to \$450,000 in purse money, there will be an additional \$100,000 bonus should a horse win all three of the prestigious Derby events.

"To link a meaningful financial bonus to the already robust purse offerings should only elevate the participation and competitiveness of the races," said Darren Dunn, Assiniboia Downs Chief Executive Officer. "It also results in a rewarding outcome for both the racing fans and related horse connections. We are excited to work collaboratively with our western provincial partners who are so energized to put an even brighter spotlight on these historic Derby events."

Allen Goodsell, Racing Manager at Century Casinos, saluted officials at both Assiniboia Downs and Hastings Racecourse for their participation. "This initiative will bring additional fanfare and excitement to Western Canada's premier races for three-year-olds," Goodsell said. "We look forward to additional collaboration in the future which only strengthens our collective industries."

Nichelle Milner, BC Director of Racing, is pleased Manitoba and Alberta asked Hastings Racecourse to be involved in the concept. "A Western Canadian Triple Crown has such great potential. I can see eventually awarding points for first, second and third place finishes and have the top three connections profit from it. We're thrilled to be part of it."



American horse with Venezuelan connections gives Castellano first Derby win


