Ostrove Wins Player's Choice Tourney by 80 Cents

Late bet cancellation turns out to be winning move

Brad Ostrove squeaked out a nail biter in the Player's Choice Tournament last Saturday, and it all came down to a late decision to cancel a bet when he didn't get his price.

The 59-year-old lifetime handicapper won a tournament last year, but he didn't think he'd be in the running this time with a total bankroll of \$97.40.

You normally have to double your money to \$120 to have a shot to win, and Ostrove thought the best he could do was third or fourth, but his late decision to cancel a wager on a 3-1 horse he thought should have been higher odds turned out to be a winning move.

The 3-1 horse ended up running out of the money and Ostrove's last contest wager finished third, paying \$4.90, which was just enough to get

him home on top, 80 cents ahead of veteran handicappers Larry Liebrecht (\$96.60) and Ron Phelps (\$96.50), followed by Darcy Penner (\$85.80) and Scott Anderson (\$80.10).

It was a tough day for longshots, but Ostrove scored early with Adaline Julia (10-1) in Race 9 at Churchill Downs and later in the day with Boss of All (10-1) in Race 11 at Belmont.

"The horse at Belmont was coming off a layoff but he had some good back form," said Ostrove. "The race looked wide open, and I knew he'd be a price. The horse at Churchill was probably my best bet of the whole day. I loved that horse. I just thought the race would set up perfectly for him. He had tactical speed and he sat right off everybody. The other horse I liked in the race opened up on him in the stretch, and I thought he was going to run away with it, but my horse kept coming to get by late."

Ostrove likes to figure out how a race will set up and then pick a horse that can take advantage of that. He also looks at certain trainers, and he doesen't necessarily look at recent form.

"If a horse has some good races in their lines further back, and the race looks like it might set up for them, that's how I find a lot of my price horses," said Ostrove. "Especially closers. A lot of closers you'll see the last four of five races they were nowhere but before that you can see a few races that would be good enough to win. I look for prices though, 6-1 or better. I'm not a favourites player."

Like so may of us, Ostrove started coming to the track in the 1960s with his dad.

"I think I was 7-8 years old when I started," said Ostrove. "He'd bet \$2 a race for us on whatever horse we wanted. We cashed a few tickets, and we used to pick up tickets off the floor, and find the odd winner that way too. That got me started and I've been going ever since."

Ostrove is also one of the people you'll meet at the Fan Appreciation Booth when you enter the track, answering questions about handicapping, betting, reading the program and now...



Sincere Condolences: Charles "Charlie" Edwin Smith

January 27, 1949 — April 21, 2023

Local racing fans and horsepeople were saddened to hear that trainer Charlie Smith passed away on April 21. The 74-year-old trainer from Annetta, Texas had many close friends at Assiniboia Downs, won numerous stakes races here, and set a record in the Debutante Stakes that will likely never be broken.

Charlie saddled 332 winners for purse earnings of \$4,034,016 for himself and his wife Terry Propps, and much of that came courtesy of stakes winners at Assiniboia Downs including Miss Missile, Portales, Lady Countdown, Morsel, Ruby's Big Band, Little Widow Maker, Gospel Gal, and Spider's Alibi.

Charlie set a local record when he won five Debutante Stakes in a row here from 2007 to 2011, and he just missed winning it again in 2012 with Portales, who made up for that loss with a victory in the Winnipeg Futurity.

Growing up in north-central Texas on acreage with cows and saddle ponies, Charlie graduated with a law degree in 1974. He took out his trainer's license in the late '80s and

credited much of his success to Terry, who selected horses at the sales, organized matings, and set up a nutrition program.

Charlie said he just tried to pay attention to detail and give the horses a good start and a regular exercise program, but it was more than that. It was time spent with the horses, by both him and Terry, and it paid off handsomely with numerous stakes winners both south of the border and at Assiniboia Downs.

Charlie was soft-spoken, but always gave you the impression that he wasn't the kind of person you wanted to mess with. Few know that before he became a lawyer and horse trainer, he was also an all-American swimmer in both high school and university. And if you were in a race against him, you always knew he was the one to beat.

"He loved Winnipeg," said Terry. "He loved the people, he loved the track, he loved everything about it. He made a lot of close friends there. He and Bruce Stratton would talk 70 times in a night. And he loved Rob Atras to death. If he could have come to Winnipeg in the last few years he would have been there."

Never one to brag about his accomplishments, besides being a stakes-winning trainer, Smith was also an excellent lawyer, and early in his career he won a huge lawsuit against a major firm in a David vs Goliath battle.

He wore a cowboy hat and boots to court, rode motorcycles across Europe, and "did not miss a minute," said Terry. "At his memorial we played My Way by Willie Nelson, Forever Young by Bob Dillon and Wild Horses by the Rolling Stones."

"He did it Charlie's way."


"I Won Bigg" Wagering Group

A Snapshot in Time

What can you say about Clayton Gray that hasn't already been said? The Dominion City native trained horses at the Downs for more than 30 seasons and ranks amongst the Downs Top 10 all-time leading trainers. Gray racked up 600 career wins at ASD and was the Downs leading trainer on seven occasions (1970, 72, 73, 74, 76, 79 and 1980). Quite a distinguished record when you consider his 20-year absence from the local racing scene (1981-2002) when he raced full-time south of the border. The superb judge of horse flesh


148th Preakness: Mage Chases Triple Crown Dream
