










2023 Las Vegas Challenge Handicapping Tournaments



Whitehall, Aebly, Win Big in Weather Shortened Week Aebly scores hat trick on Monday, Whitehall wins four on Wednesday

Hot apprentice Fraser Aebly scored a hat trick on Monday, leading rider Antonio Whitehall stole the show on Wednesday with four wins, and trainer Jerry Gourneau continued to march towards his record fourth consecutive trainer title with a triple of his own in a weather-shortened week.

The races were cancelled on Tuesday in consideration of the safety of the horses and their riders, as smoke from the wildfires in Alberta and B.C. continued to waft their way to Manitoba, but there was no stopping Aebly, Whitehall and Gourneau from continuing their meet-long rolls to victory.

Aebly scored a natural hat trick on Monday, winning the second race aboard Shootin Money (\$5.20) for trainer Wendy Anderson, the third on Kontie (\$4.30) for Lise Pruitt and the fourth aboard The Lonna Ranger (\$6.10), again for Wendy Anderson. The 19-year-old apprentice from Grand Prairie, Alberta has been splitting his time between Assiniboia Downs and Hastings Racecourse this year as he prepares to take his tack to Woodbine in the fall, and he's riding beyond his years.

Aebly has won 17 races at Assiniboia Downs and is winning at a 20 percent clip here, while also winning 22 races at Hastings Racecourse to sit fourth in the standings there. The 4' 11" 105-pounder could have his apprentice allowance to the end of the Woodbine meeting next year, which would provide a tremendous advantage to trainers there, as it has here.

Leading rider Antonio Whitehall continued his dominant roll at the top of the local standings with a single on Monday and a four-bagger on Wednesday. The last time the two-time leading rider had four wins on a card here was when he won his second title in 2020.

Whitehall won the first race on Monday aboard One Sky (\$5.40) for trainer Cal Britton and followed up Wednesday with a natural hat trick in the first three races and another victory in the sixth race. Whitehall won the first race aboard Kim's Texas Bling (\$3.10) for trainer Jerry Gourneau, the second on Drop a Caribou (\$6.00) for Shelley Brown, the third aboard Annakhozana (\$3.10), again for Gourneau, and then gave Exchequer (\$10.40) a dream inside trip stalking a duel to win the sixth race for trainer Will Tourangeau.

Whitehall's five-win week vaulted him into what looks like an insurmountable lead in the jockey standings with 49 wins, 14 more than Damario Bynoe (35 wins), followed by Jorge Carreno (29), Chavion Chow (29) and Ronald Ali (24). Two of Whitehall's three wins also helped trainer Jerry Gourneau score a hat trick on Wednesday.

Gourneau's lead in the trainer standings also looks insurmountable with only six race days left in the live race meeting. The 61-year-old conditioner from the Turtle Mountain Chippewa Reservation in Belcourt, North Dakota now has 39 wins, 11 more than Wendy Anderson (28), followed by Jared Brown (25), Mike Nault (23) and Devon Gittens (21). The common thread that runs through all three of these winners – Gourneau, Whitehall and Aebly?

They put the work in.

Top NFL Picks by TravyFootball: Week 1

Falcons over Panthers (Sunday noon): Once again, the hype train has taken off when it comes to the Atlanta Falcons. Every year they trick people into believing that they will be a decent team, and every year they always disappoint. Second year QB Desmond Riddler will be the starter headed into week one, and has had some decent weapons to work with in Kyle Pitts, Drake London, and rookie running back Bijan Robinson. This will also be the debut game for first overall pick, Bryce Young, at QB for the Panthers. Based on



what I saw during the pre-season, Young will be running for his life quite often behind a very shaky offensive line, and the Panthers might be vying for the first overall pick in 2024 as well.

Packers over Bears (Sunday afternoon): The revamped Chicago Bears will open their season hosting their division rivals, the Green Bay Packers, at Soldier Field. This will be the first time in about 18 years where Aaron Rodgers (who destroyed the Bears every time they played) will not be involved. The awkwardness of not seeing number 12 lined up under centre for Green Bay will probably take some time getting used to, but for the sake of Packer fans, hopefully not too long. New starting quarterback Jordan Love will look to extend the winning streak to nine straight Packers victories over the Bears.

Cowboys over Giants (Sunday night): I really hate saying anything positive about the Dallas Cowboys, but it would be naïve of me to think that they aren't one of the top contenders in the NFC once again. I'll even go as far as saying they might make it to the NFC championship game this season, but it's very hard to trust this team when it comes to the playoffs (especially if they run into the 49ers). They will go on the road in Week One to face a team that they have owned over the past few years, the New York Giants. After handing Daniel Jones a large contract extension in the off-season, the Giants will look to build on the success they had last year. Even those whole division matchups tend to be tougher. I don't expect any upset here and Dallas should win this one pretty comfortably.



Few Canadian bred 3-year-olds are afraid of King's Plate winner Paramount Prince



King's Plate winner Paramount Prince has not scared many away from the second jewel of the Canadian Triple Crown, as he will meet 11 rivals in the \$400,000 Prince of Wales Stakes at Fort Erie, on Tuesday, September 12.
