# Two New Sires for Manitoba Canadian Classic winner Ami's Holiday, Vosburgh Stakes winner Following Sea



Vosburgh Stakes (G2) winner Following Sea is on his way to Manitoba to stand at stud.

Two new sires are coming to Manitoba, and both were serious runners.

Canadian classic winner Ami's Holiday, among the leading sires in Canada with just four crops of racing age, will stand the 2024 breeding season at 2 Points Ranch in Manitoba in partnership with owner and breeder Ivan Dalos, who had stood the son of Harlan's Holiday at Colebrook Farms Ontario.

And Vosburgh Stakes (G2) winner Following Sea has been purchased by longtime owner-breeder-trainer Garry Naherniak and is expected to arrive in Manitoba in three weeks.

Ami's Holiday is by Harlan's Holiday, sire of North America's number one stallion Into Mischief, and he has already started to make a name for himself as a stallion in Ontario. Following Sea is by Eclipse Award winning sprinter Runhappy, and also brings an excellent racing resume to Manitoba. Not only did he win the Vosburgh Stakes, he also finished second in the Cigar Mile (G1) and the Haskell Invitational (G1), and a troubled third in the 2021 Breeders' Cup Sprint (G1). Naherniak has not decided where Following Sea is going to stand in Manitoba, but he is sure to attract some lookers, as will Ami's Holiday.

#### Top NFL Picks by TravyFootball: Week 9

Raiders over Giants (Sunday afternoon): The Giants lost the battle of New York last week against the Jets on a field goal with time expiring. It might have been the single worst passing performance in the history of the NFL. After Tyrod Taylor went down with a rib injury, backup quarterback Tony Davito (I know ALOT of QBs, and even I haven't heard of this guy) came in and proceeded to throw 7 passes...in the ENTIRE GAME! What's even more astonishing is that the two passes he completed actually



went for negative yards, so he finished with a whopping -1 yard.

The Giants as a whole finished the game 6/14 for 7 yards. I'm pretty sure even I could complete a pass for the Giants at this point. It's a far cry from where they were last year at this time. The Raiders seem to have a Jimmy Garoppolo problem. I will always be grateful to Jimmy for helping guide my 49ers to the Super Bowl a few years ago, but I will never forgive him for overthrowing Emmanuel Sanders. That would've actually WON us the Super Bowl, but I digress. It seems that all his bad habits have carried over to the Raiders now, and certain players are starting to get frustrated with him. I think the defense will win this game for the Raiders anyway. I was writing this late Tuesday night when the news broke that the Raiders fired Head Coach Josh McDaniels. Can't say I'm surprised but considering they only hired him in 2022, they still will be paying him ALOT of money for the next four years. It also seems like Jimmy G will be benched in favour of rookie Aiden O'Connell.

Falcons over Vikings (Sunday noon): Obviously, the biggest news for the Vikings from last week was Kirk Cousins tearing his Achilles tendon. In a corresponding move, Minnesota acquired Josh Dobbs from the Arizona Cardinals on trade deadline day to try and soften the blow a little bit. There's no way Dobbs will ever replicate the production of Cousins, but having a veteran quarterback, instead of trying out a rookie or a second-year player with very little experience, is a much better option. Expect the Vikings to be run heavy for the next couple of games while Josh Dobbs learns the offense. A little-known fact about Dobbs, not only is he a professional NFL quarterback which is hard enough, but he's also an Aerospace Engineer. So, something tells me it won't take him long to learn the playbook. I called it last week when saying the leash on Falcons QB Desmond Ridder was getting shorter. Well, he finally got benched after yet another poor performance. They said it was for Riddler's safety (he had been sacked five times and had to go into the blue medical tent) but even once he was cleared to return to the game, the coach still held him out. My personal opinion, I don't think his health had anything to do with why he didn't go back into the game.... Back up Taylor Heinicke, who flashed some good moments when he was in Washington, took over for Ridder and had mix results, but he did get the Falcons back into the game after they were down 21-9 for the majority of it.

Eagles over Cowboys (Sunday afternoon): A heavyweight tilt on tap in NFC east will pit the Eagles against the Cowboys in what will essentially be a battle for first place in the division. I don't think there's been a more dominant receiver in the NFL right now than AJ Brown. In his last three games, he has tallied 25 receptions for 398 yards and three touchdowns, including a beautiful one-handed grab against the Washington commanders last week. As much as it pains me to say this, I think Philadelphia is the team to beat right now and nobody has been able to solve the "tush push" play yet. But I don't think their defense is as strong as it was last season and Dallas may be able to take advantage of that. The Cowboys seem to have gotten their mojo back and made easy work of the Rams last week putting up 30 points before halftime as they were probably more concerned about this showdown with the Eagles. If they can play like that again, this should be a competitive hard-fought game that will come down to maybe a last second field goal.



#### A Snapshot in Time



Wasn't that early blast from "Old Man Winter" a shocker!? It's always such a downer when snow comes before Halloween. Thing is, it got the history guy to thinking about Downs race meets that went into the month of November, and that, my friends will be our theme for the next few weeks.

Let's start with 1979. The 131-day meet came to a close on November 4th. Newspaper accounts of the day reflect that on Sunday, November 4th, the season came to an abrupt ending when the jockeys refused to ride after the 5th race because of bad weather and a track that some riders felt was not safe. A search of our photo archive came up dry for a win photo from November 4, but here is one from Saturday night November 3rd. The 9th race was the 21st running of the R. J. Speers Memorial Handicap that was won by Nick

Block's Scarlet Rich with Peter McAleney in the saddle. Anyone notice that Bob King is the man holding the 8-year-old chestnut stallion for the win photo. (Gerry Hart photo)
