Handicapper's Corner

A Pick 6 Strategy that won't break the bank, but might fill your wheelbarrow



The Pick 6 can pay huge, even if a few heavy favourites win. Good to know.

The Handicapper of the Year title is on the line this Saturday in the final Player's Choice Handicapping tournament of the year. Deadline to enter is 4 p.m. Friday. First prize is \$1,000. Are you in?

There are at least 10 handicappers that have a shot at the Handicapper of the Year title and the \$3,500 cash prize and trophy that goes with it, but the top five in the standings going into the final round are Glen Gray, Nicole Baker, Randy Premachuk, Steve Holborn and Keith MacLennan.

Every handicapper in the standings knows what they're doing, meaning that if you see them in the clubhouse and you don't feel like handicapping, they can give you a horse and an angle to go with it. If the horse doesn't win, it will rarely be for lack of trying. Horses that try, with jockeys that give them their best chance to win, from handicappers who know the difference, are among the best bets in racing, which brings us to our next subject, *The Pick 6 in a Bottle,* an article that originally appeared in the revised edition of *The Best of Thoroughbred Handicapping,* by James Quinn.

The article describes a method of playing the Pick 6 used by Gibson Carouthers to make multiple big scores. Carouthers' strategy combines two types of horses -- singles and covers.

There are two types of singles - separators and standouts – each of which must be recognized in order to have success with horse racing's toughest but most lucrative bet. Even with a few standouts at low odds, the Pick 6 can still pay huge says Carouthers, so why play against them. It's not worth the effort to try to beat them if they're authentic standouts. It's the separators that are the key to riches.

"I fought standouts for far too long," said Carouthers in the article. "It's a reflection of my hatred for chalk. All it takes are a couple of big scores with a couple of even-money standouts, and you'll change your mind. I sure did."

Standouts are easier to find than separators, but the latter are the horses that eliminate the majority of players from the pool. The odds are higher on separators, but they figure to have a better chance to win than their odds indicate, as based on solid handicapping and favourite angles. It's important to understand that separators are not longshots with a low probability of winning, but rather horses that have a solid chance to win at a good price.

Carouthers finds his separators by doing serious research on the Result Charts, which most bettors will not do. Watching replays is similar, and can also identify separators, but every handicapper will use their own favourite method or angle for finding these lucrative singles.

Once separators and standouts have been identified, Carouthers will use every horse with a handicapper's chance to win in the other legs of his Pick 6 tickets. He also adds never to leave out just one horse in a race, and says that if you have identified just two horses to use as "covers" in a race, you probably need to do more work.

"That's an admission that you don't know who's going to win, yet you're probably not going to go deep enough to cover."

Carouther's system only works if you are a solid, comprehensive handicapper and you do the extra work to find horses others will miss, but...


"One good thing about this style of play is that you rarely feel bad when you lose," said Carouthers. "If your separator loses you went down with your main play. If a standout loses, he still wasn't worth trying to beat."

And if you lose a race where you have numerous "cover" horses based on solid handicapping, a good handicapper knows they could never have used the winner regardless.

Carouther's method won't break the bank, and if you can find your separators, you might just win...

Top NFL Picks by TravyFootball: Week 15

Bengals over Vikings (Saturday noon): We're almost midway through December so you know what that means, time for NFL football Saturdays! At some point in the future, we're just going to have NFL games every day of the week, which I wouldn't be opposed to.

Up first on the schedule, the Bengals and the Vikings. The Josh Dobbs experiment is officially over as Coach O'Connell has decided to turns things over to Nick Mullens to try and jumpstart the offense. I guess when you only manage 63 yards on 23 passing attempts, that's cause to lose your starting gig. I can't really fault Dobbs, he is what he is, nothing more, nothing less.

On the other side of field will be another backup quarterback, Jake Browning, who will be making his 4th career start for the Bengals. Oddly enough, Browning signed with the Vikings as an undrafted free agent in 2019. It didn't quite work out for him there and he was released in 2021, but I'm pretty sure he carries a chip on his shoulder and wants to prove to the Vikings they made a mistake in releasing him.

Bills over Cowboys (Sunday afternoon): Dallas has a tough three game stretch coming up. I guess technically it's a four game stretch if you include the Eagles game from last week, but now they have to travel to Buffalo to face the Bills. Thanks to an offside penalty that caused Patrick Mahomes to throw quite the temper tantrum on the sidelines after the game was over, Buffalo got a much needed victory that keeps their playoff chances alive.

I'm not sure what the weather forecast will be, but I can't imagine a team like the Cowboys, who play in a Texas dome stadium, will want to be outdoors in the middle of December in Buffalo. Josh Allen wasn't exactly spectacular against the Chiefs last week, but he did just enough with his arm, and his legs, to get the job done.

Lions over Broncos (Saturday night): Detroit chose a really bad time to start playing poorly, and if they keep it up their stay in the playoffs won't be a long one. The good thing for them is they still have a comfortable lead on the next closest team in the NFC North (the Vikings). But, if they want to KEEP that lead, they need to play better, more specifically, the defense can't continue to give up 25+ points a game.

Ever since the week before Halloween, the defense can't seem to stop anyone from scoring, and what is compounding that problem is that the offense is starting to turn the ball over too much. Quarterback Jared Goff has reverted back to the 2020 version of himself, the version that got him traded from the Rams to the Lions in the first place. A very hot Broncos team is coming to town, but I think Detroit will bounce back from their loss last week to the Bears.





Phil D'Amato takes on the Baffert trio with graded stakes-placed Stronghold




Wine Me Up training for the Los Alamitos Futurity at Santa Anita. (Chad B. Harmon photo)
