

Fans from around the world and on-track wagered over \$60 million on Assiniboia Downs in 2023, average wagering per race was up almost 10% over the previous season, the horses were classier, trainers had their horses ready, and an excellent jockey colony gave fans their money's worth every night.

Leading trainer Jerry Gourneau won his record fourth straight training title and fifth overall, and capped the season off with his first ever win in the \$125,000 Manitoba Derby with Mano Dura for Henry S. Witt, Jr., who led the owner standings for the fifth consecutive year. The win was also the highlight of the year for jockey Antonio Whitehall, who won his third jockey title at the Downs in 2023 with 56 wins.

The prize money was widely distributed among owners, trainers and breeders in 2023, the Manitoba Yearling Sale average was up again, and <u>breeders</u> continued to bolster their broodmare bands with better mares. There seemed to be more smiles than ever in 2023 on the faces of grooms, jockeys, owners and trainers, and track photographer Jason Halstead captured many of them in the photos below. Thanks Jason!

It won't be long now until spring training arrives and the horses are back in action carrying the hopes and dreams of the people who love them.







Top NFL Picks by TravyFootball: Week 17

Cowboys over Lions (Saturday night): It's been a rough couple of weeks for "dem boys" as of late. Coming off back-to-back losses to the AFC East, Dallas will go back home to Jerry world and host the newly crowned NFC North champion Detroit Lions. It's funny how Dak Prescott went from MVP favourite, to people once again questioning if he's "the guy" to get Dallas over the hump. I do think they'll end their two-game losing streak here because DC Dan Quinn will most likely send a lot of pressure from his defense at Lions QB



Jared Goff, who doesn't seem to handle it well. The Lions defense has played slightly better the last couple weeks, but I don't think they will be able to slow down the Dallas offense at all.

Bears over Falcons (Sunday noon): I continue to believe Atlanta is one of the fraudulent teams in the NFL. How they managed to pull off seven wins this season is beyond me. They have two bad quarterbacks, underutilized receivers, and a defense that isn't very good. Despite all that, they're only one game back of the division lead in the NFC south. They definitely play better at home indoor on the turf, so a trip to Chicago in December probably won't work out well for them. If the Bears could ever have gotten consistent play out of Justin Fields, they probably would've had a much better record than 6-9. Their defense has definitely stepped it up over the last month, not quite '85 Bears, but formidable enough to the point where they are averaging only 16 points against in their last three games.

Giants over Rams (Sunday noon): This would definitely be considered an upset if it goes the way I think it might. It looks like the era of Tommy DeVito is over as he was benched at halftime against the Eagles last week. Tyrod Taylor came in and provided a much-needed spark to the offense. I always feel that teams that play indoors, like the Rams, tend to struggle when playing outdoors in the cold elements. On paper Los Angeles

is the much superior team, but maybe the Giants' defense can force Stafford into a few errant throws that will keep this game closer than it should be.




